



# Webb Wilder Salutes a "New Day"

Single Release date Jan. 15th  
Taking Airplay Now



2021 will be new in so many ways. In the spirit of hope and optimism after what has been a difficult year to say the least, Webb Wilder was reminded of a song he wrote back in the early 90's and so, contacted frequent collaborator, the "Tone Chaperone" George Bradfute, with whom he worked on a radio edit of the single "New Day" to celebrate the dawning of what will surely be a better year.

Webb remarks, "Since there's been so much talk about 2020 being an awful year and we are now in a new one with a new president about to take office, and a new, eagerly awaited vaccine for the Pandemic that kept so many of us in isolation in 2020 beginning to get distributed, I thought maybe a rousing, rocking song about a "new day" might be in order. George and I had worked together on the Powerful Stuff album which being an archival release had given us the opportunity to find some overlooked gems and even re-mix some of them. Such was the case with "New Day." It was only after the album came out that I realized it was five minutes and 44 seconds long! What with the subject matter being more relevant now, it seemed like a more radio friendly single version could work."

"I wrote this song with Terry Anderson (Yayhoos, writer of "Battleship Chains"), and The Beatnecks and I recorded it in 1993. It lay dormant until Landslide released an archival album of previously unreleased recordings in 2018, *Powerful Stuff*. I hope everyone hearing it takes it in the rocking and optimistic spirit it was written and recorded. Welcome 2021."
